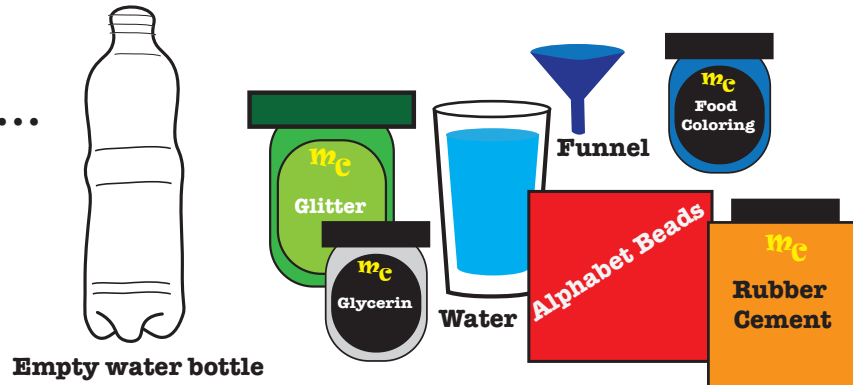


# Letter Finder Toy

You Will Need...

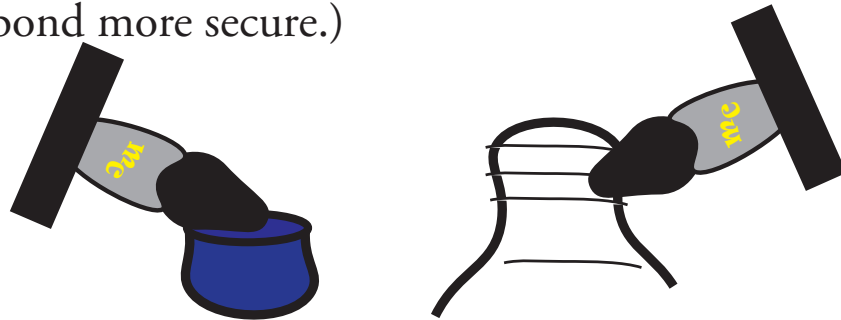


1. Using the funnel, partially fill the empty water bottle with water.

2. Next, add a few drops of food coloring. Once the food coloring has been mixed well, add a few drops of glycerin and mix everything well.

3. Third, carefully drop alphabet beads into the water bottle. Then put in the desired amount of glitter. (It can take the glitter several months to thoroughly mix and settle.)

4. Now, take a little runner cement and put some on the threads of the top of the bottle. Then put rubber cement inside the cap of the bottle. (Having rubber cement on both sides will help make the glue bond more secure.)



5. Fifth, add additional water (if needed) and tighten down the bottle top on the bottle.
