

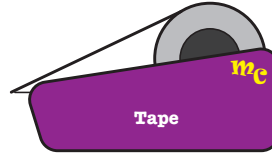
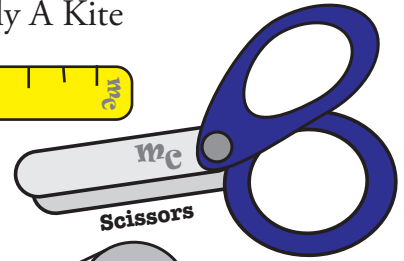
# Decorative Kite

Ruler

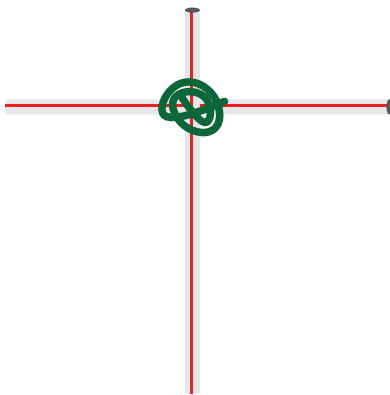


Drinking Straws



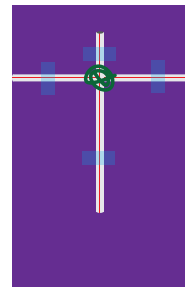
1.

Take two clean drinking straws and make a lower-case letter 't.' Wrap yarn around the 't' so it holds together well.



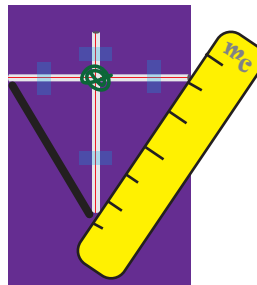
2.

Next, tape the 't' to the construction paper.

Once the 't' has been attached to the paper, take a ruler and line it point-to-point with the 't.' With the marker and ruler, draw straight lines to the four points of the 't.'

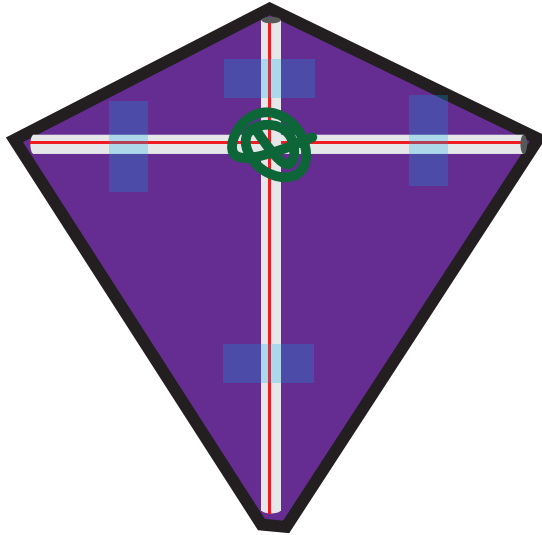


# Decorative Kite

Fourth, carefully with scissors, cut along the straight lines. **REMEMBER!** *Any time a child uses scissors, there must be an adult present.*

Finally, tie yarn to the top of your kite, and with your special adult's permission (teacher, parent, sitter, grandparent, et cetera), pretend to fly the kite.
